We are an organisation that prides itself on achieving our aims and objectives through actions. The actions we will take, and have taken, to achieve our environmental goals are:

1. Install a solar array on our headquarters to power our facility and feed surplus energy back to the grid.
2. Recycle our waste metals, consumables and materials where possible.
3. Reduce the use of single-use consumables in our operations.
4. Develop and manufacture equipment that is "built to last" with the ability to repair rather than replace.
5. Design energy efficient equipment.
6. Prioritise low carbon ocean freight over air freight for logistics solutions.

8. Source 100% of our energy from renewable sources through the Tasmanian energy network.
